Hot Weather

Please ensure your child has appropriate **sun lotion** and this is applied before they come to nursery school. A **hat** during the hot weather is essential along with clothes that cover the skin to prevent sunburn. They can also bring a bottle with **water** in to keep in the box above their peg. Please remember that children are only able to have water in their bottles and not juice. We operate a healthy eating policy and also some children have allergies to the colouring and flavourings in juice.
